First call: IWRM MoMo wrap-up and relay conference

The 3rd phase of the German-Mongolian Project “Integrated Water Resources Management in Central Asia: Model Region Mongolia (IWRM-MoMo)” will be finished in 2018 after 12 years of research, international cooperation, technical implementation and capacity building funded by the German Ministry of Education and Research.

On 29 to 30 May 2018 the IWRM MoMo wrap-up and relay conference will be held in Ulaanbaatar, Mongolia.

The event will reflect the whole scope of topics that have been studied, the partners together with the MoMo-team will wrap-up the broad range of achievements of the all three project phases and will share the “lessons learnt”.
